### **Award Descriptions**

**Trailblazer Award:** Awarded to a pioneer black journalist of extraordinary accomplishment who has broken barriers and blazed trails. Nominees may be living or deceased and have contributed to the understanding or advancement of people and issues in the African Diaspora.

**Journalist of the Year** (One or more honorees to be selected from the broadcast, print and/or online fields, at the discretion of the committee/board): Awarded to a black journalist who has distinguished himself or herself with a body of work from the 2010 calendar year that was extraordinary in depth, scope or significance to African Americans or the African Diaspora. At least three but no more than five work samples are required, such as a combination of a story or stories, series, newscast, videos and/or photographs published or broadcast during the past year. Length of work samples are at the discretion of nominator; links to work online is acceptable.

**Community Service Award:** Awarded to a journalist, member of the media or community person who has had a positive impact on the black community.

**Lifetime Achievement:** Awarded to a black print, broadcast, online or photojournalist with a minimum of 15 years in the industry. Nominees in the category may be living or deceased and must have or still be making an extraordinary contribution to the enrichment, understanding or advancement of black life and culture.

**Nomination Process:** All nominations should include: an application, a resume, biographical information, an essay clearly explaining why that person should be considered, and any other supporting documentation. Journalist of the Year nominations must also include at least three but no more than five work samples work from the 2010 calendar year. Online links to the nominee's work samples are acceptable. The nomination packets should be sent to the Awards Committee's attention by the published deadline date.
